Activity

This activity affirms that all questions are OK, Mary asked questions to the Angel. This activity acknowledges that some questions are very difficult to answer. The focus of this activity is on the asking and not the answering – Faith & trusting that God hears and works all things together for the good of those who love Him. Everyone has big questions about life. What are your big questions? There may be areas of your faith you struggle with or long for answers. If you could ask God one question right now, what would you ask? Once you've written it / them down in one of the speech bubbles on the paper. Move onto the prayers below, then spend some time listening with an open Bible and open heart of faith.

Prayer of Faith

Thank You Lord You are Faithful, True and Fully Trustworthy. Lord thank you that your word says I can pour out my heart to You, for you are our source, refuge, and strength. Lord thank you that Faith is your gift to me and even when I face big questions I may have, trials or even testing, that you are refining me, shaping me a moulding me and producing character and perseverance. Lord that you are strengthening my faith. Thank you, Lord, for this faith You provide that brings confidence in what we hope for, the assurance of what we do not see. Thank you for what we do see, we see your goodness in Jesus our Lord and King. Amen.

Repentance Prayer

Father God, I confess there are times where I feel weak in faith, times when I question you, where I lean on my understanding rather than on Your faithfulness and goodness. Help me Lord Jesus to lean not on my own understanding but in all my ways to acknowledge you, placing my faith in the hope and assurance of what Christ has done, and to faithfully walk in the path that you straighten for me. Amen
